

This licence is granted pursuant to Section 2 of the Road Traffic and Transport Act 2006, and entitles the holder to carry on a road haulage business for hire or reward within the State and qualifies the holder to carry on a road haulage business for hire or reward outside the State with such vehicles as may be specified on the licence.

This licence shall come into effect on 03/04/2007 and shall continue in force up to and including 02/04/2012 unless terminated sooner.

1. The licence holder shall continue to comply throughout the duration of the licence with the requirements for obtaining the licence.
2. The Department of Transport reserves the right to check at any stage during the validity of this licence that the holder continues to satisfy the requirements on the basis of which the licence was originally granted. Holding a licence does not of itself constitute proof that the holder continues to fulfill these requirements.
3. The licence holder must be in possession of a transport disc for each vehicle specified on the licence, a valid Community authorisation, and a certified copy of the Community authorisation for each vehicle specified on the licence.
4. The licence holder must display the transport disc on the windscreen of the appropriate vehicle, carry the certified copy of the Community Authorisation in the appropriate vehicle, and carry the current licence or a copy of the current licence in the vehicle, for every vehicle specified on the licence.
5. The Department of Transport must be notified if this licence, the Community authorisation, a certified copy of a Community authorisation, or a transport disc is lost or destroyed
6. If a vehicle is being added to the licence, then the licence must be returned to the Department of Transport for amendment.
7. If a vehicle is being substituted or removed from the licence, then the licence must be returned to the Department of Transport for amendment, together with the certified copy of the Community authorisation and the transport disc of the vehicle being removed or substituted.
8. If there is a change of name or address of the licence holder, then the licence must be returned to the Department of Transport for amendment, together with the Community Authorisation, all certified copies of the Community authorisation and all transport discs.
9. If there is a change of name or address of the transport manager, then the licence must be returned to the Department of Transport for amendment.
10. The licence may only be amended by Department of Transport officials authorised by the Minister.
11. This licence, or a copy of this licence, must be produced for inspection on request to any member of the Garda Síochána or to a Transport Officer of the Department of Transport.
12. This licence is personal to the holder and is not transferrable except when authorised by the Department of Transport.
13. The licence holder must supply information relating to the business operated under the licence when requested by the Central Statistics Office.
14. The licence holder must ensure that adequate parking spaces and operating premises are provided within the State for all vehicles being operated.
